Global appreciation of the project and area for improvement

Overall, the IDEX funds have not been used as a catalyst for initial firm in a significant sale. The original IDEX plan has been pursued, and progress has been made piecemeal. Although the potential of the excellence of the individual members is great, the IDEX has not yet managed to capture and support excellence, create an integrated ecosystem which can become viable internationally. Recent attempts (post 2015) to do the job have been positive, but the convincing health of the IDEX will be met. Therefore, we recommend that the probationary period for the end of which, the following points will be clearly:
